

Your Rights under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964

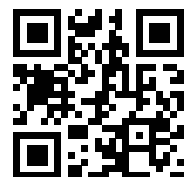
Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VI) requires that no person in the United States, on the grounds of race, color or national origin be excluded from, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance. Presidential Executive Order 12898 addresses environmental justice in minority and low-income populations. Presidential Executive Order 13166 addresses services to those individuals with limited English proficiency.

Any person who believes he or she has been excluded from, denied the benefits of, or been subjected to discrimination may file a written complaint with the Toledo Area Regional Transit Authority's Office of the General Manager. Federal and State law requires complaints be filed within one-hundred eighty (180) calendar days of the last alleged incident.
