RESOLUTION NO. 68-23

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR EXPENDITURE OF THE TOLEDO AREA REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR 2024

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Chapter 5705, requires that this Authority adopt an annual appropriations resolution for 2024 to make lawful expenditures of funds for the operations of TARTA; and

WHEREAS, a certificate of estimated resources has been received from the Joint Budget Commission of Lucas and Wood Counties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOLEDO AREA REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY, OHIO:
