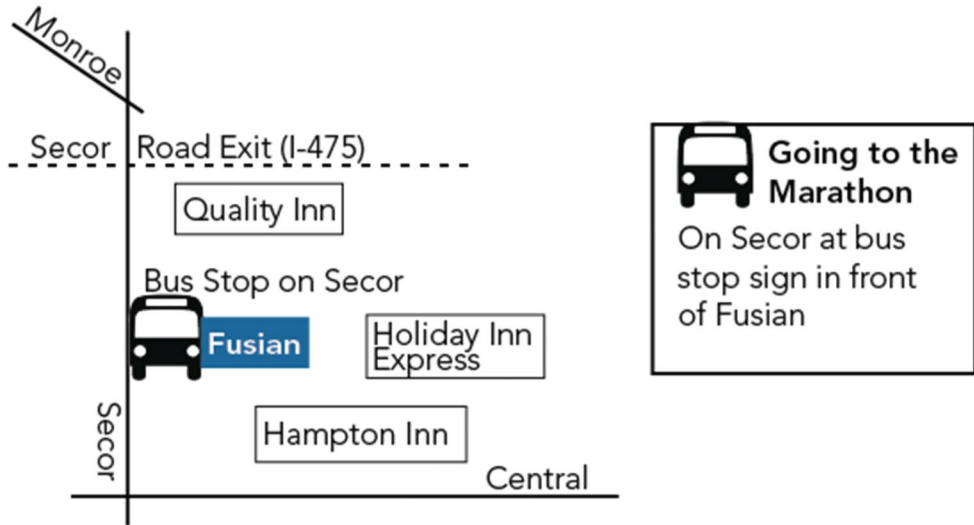
TARTA's Glass City Marathon buses will pick up from three locations: Secor Road, Downtown Toledo and Spring Meadows. Pick-up times and service frequency will vary between locations:

Glass City Marathon Bus #1	Secor Road
Going to Marathon	The Glass City Marathon bus will pick up at the TARTA bus stop on Secor Rd. in front of Fusian. Be sure the sign above the front window reads #1 Secor Rd. Departing 4:50 a.m., 5:20 a.m., 5:50 a.m. (15 min. travel time)
Returning from Marathon	Return to drop-off location at the UT Transit Center on S. Towerview Blvd. Be sure the sign above the front window reads #1 Secor Rd. Departing 10:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m., 1:00 p.m., 2:00 p.m.
Glass City Marathon Bus #2	Renaissance Hotel, Downtown Toledo
Going to Marathon	The Glass City Marathon bus will pick up at the cutout on Summit St. directly in front of the Renaissance Hotel. Be sure the sign above the front window reads #2 Summit St. Departing 5:00 a.m., 5:50 a.m. (20 min. travel time)
Returning from Marathon	Return to drop-off location at the UT Transit Center on S. Towerview Blvd. Be sure the sign above the front window reads #2 Summit St. Departing 10:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m., 1:00 p.m., 2:00 p.m.
Glass City Marathon Bus #3	Spring Meadows
Going to Marathon	The Glass City Marathon bus will pick up on East Mall Drive near driveway entrance into the Marriott hotel parking. Be sure the sign above the front window reads #3 E. Mall Dr. Departing 5:00 a.m., 5:50 a.m. (20 min. travel time)
Returning from Marathon	Return to drop-off location at the UT Transit Center on S. Towerview Blvd. Be sure the sign above the front window reads #3 E. Mall Dr. Departing 10:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m., 1:00 p.m., 2:00 p.m.



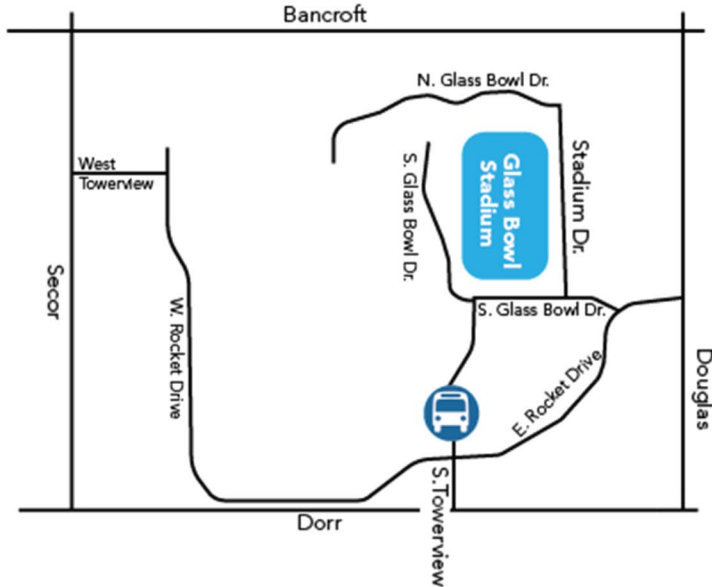
Glass City Marathon Bus #1 Map - Secor Road

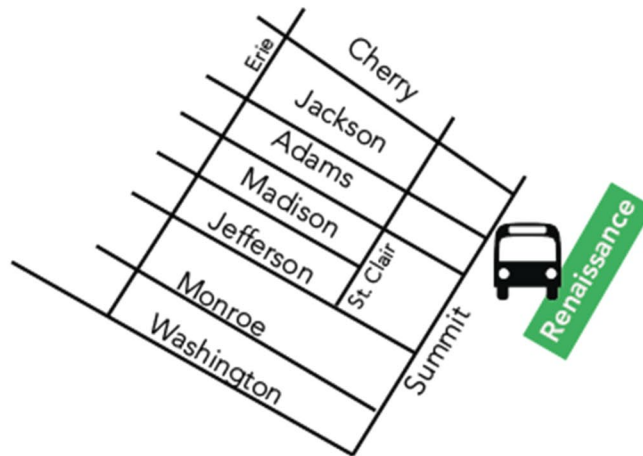
Glass City Marathon Bus #2 Map - Downtown Toledo

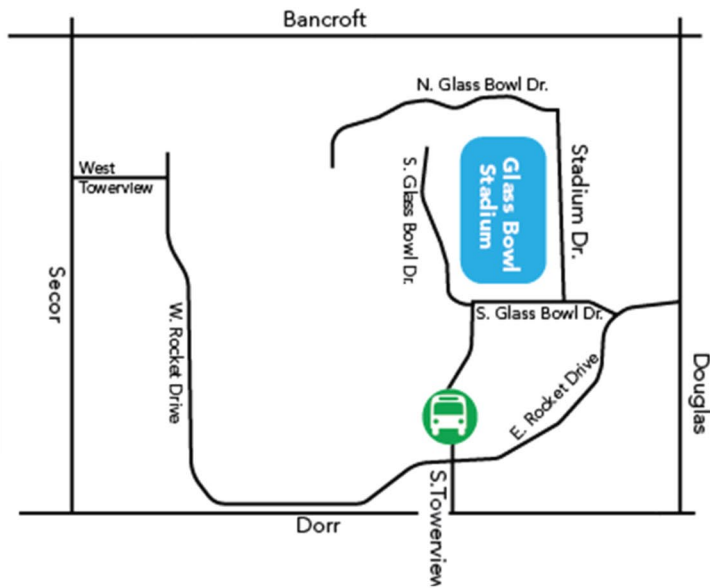

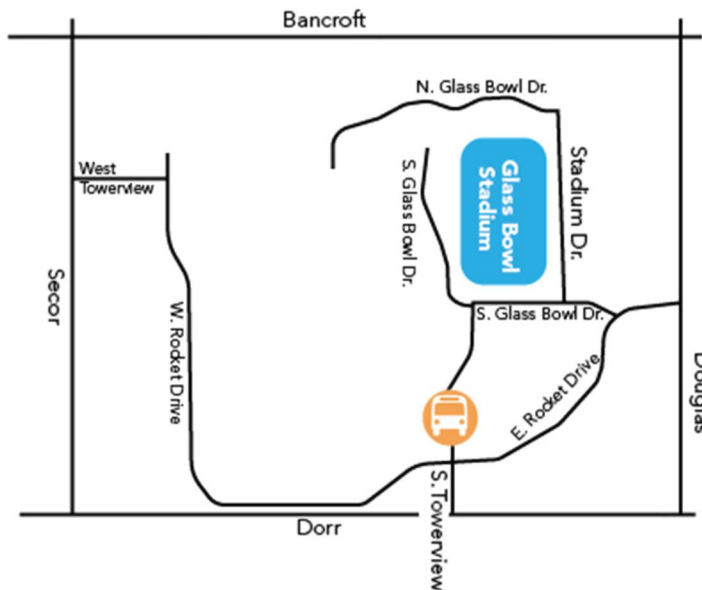

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

How do I ride?

Arrive at least five minutes early and wait on the sidewalk where the driver can see you. As the bus arrives, check the sign above the front window to be sure it's the correct bus route and direction.

Board the bus at the rear door; due to COVID-19 all passengers are required to board using the rear doors. If you have questions about whether you have the right bus or where your stop is located ask the bus driver. Listen for announcements on the next major stops and intersections.

Exit through the rear door. For your safety, never cross in front of the bus after exiting.

When will the bus pick me up?

Transportation service will begin at 5:00 a.m. and is open to the public. Pick-up times will vary between locations.

Does it cost anything to ride?

No. Rides on all TARTA vehicles are free of fare until further notice.

What if I have a question?

We are here to help before, during and after your ride. If you have questions about whether you have the right bus or where your stop is located, ask the bus driver or call TARTA's Information Line at (419) 243-7433 (RIDE). Phone lines are open weekdays from 7 a.m.-6 p.m. and on weekends and holidays from 8 a.m.-5 p.m.

Protect yourself and others.

Be prepared to follow COVID-19 safety protocols when riding the bus service. Facial coverings are required for ALL trips. Children under the age of 2 years are not required to wear a facial covering.
