Brief Updates from TARTA Staff

- o Expansion into Oregon (Susan)
 - Shared the map of the new service area with Route 2 expanding as of January 7, 2024
- o Flex (Susan)
 - Additional Flex vehicles have been delivered to TARTA and will be set to be put into service soon after they are branded
- o TARTA Next Event (Susan)
 - TARTA will be hosting an event to provide updates to the public on our TARTA Next initiative. The breakfast event will be held on November 15, 2023, at 8:00 am at the Glass City Center downtown.  - TARTA will be fare-free on Election Day, November 7 for all services fixed routes, Flex and TARPS

- Need a TARPS map on the website

New Business

- Courtesy Benches Ken Schumaker
 - City of Toledo removing bus stop benches when Ken called the city to ask, he was told it is TARTA's responsibility to replace those benches. It is NOT!
 <u>Update:</u> TARTA is already communicating with the City to replace those benches because it is the City's responsibility.
- DARC Loren Sengstock
 - Loren reported that he attended via Zoom the first meeting of DARC (Disability and Aging Passenger Coalition) hosted by the Ability Center's Katie Hunt-Thomas. This group is focusing on high speed and local rail transportation options. Their next ZOOM meeting will be November 21 at 10:30 am.
- Mission Bus Shelter Brandon Brown
 - Brandon mentioned the bus shelter was removed from Secor and Monroe Streets in front of Kroger. Shelters ARE the responsibility of TARTA and the plan is when a valid shelter is removed for various reasons (safety, upgraded amenities), it will be replaced within 30-60 days. So this shelter will be replaced soon.
